Type of wine:	Red wine made with organic grapes
Grapes:	Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Petit Verdot picked by hand
Vintage:	2018
Aging potential:	9 years
Fermentation:	Traditional fermentation
Aging:	French oak barrels and stainless steel tanks
Origin/location:	100% estate grown in our Sanel Valley Vineyards/Hopland, the southernmost town in Mendocino County
Soil:	Mostly gravelly, bench land loamy soils
Altitude:	500-600 feet above sea level
Age of vines:	Vines plots of 22, 25 and 27 years old

Tasting notes: Deep ruby color. An elegant, silky and rich wine, with layers of fruit: blackberry and currant, spices, clove, anise, as well as licorice and dark chocolate. Medium-high body, with velvety finish.
